The Sports Neuropsychology Society is seeking applications for 8-12 student volunteers for the Concussion & Brain Health Symposium, which will be held May 14-16, 2026 in Cleveland, OH. Applications will be accepted from active undergraduate and graduate students, employed research assistants who are not currently in a training program, and post-doctoral fellows. Student volunteers will receive free conference registration. Volunteers will be expected to volunteer in blocks of time to assist with various tasks during the symposium (e.g., registration) and will be given opportunities to attend nearly all of the conference.

Application for Student Travel Stipends!

The Sports Neuropsychology Society is also seeking applications for Student Travel Stipends. Recipients will receive free conference registration and a stipend to help defray symposium travel costs. Stipend amount will be based on available funds. Applications will be accepted from active undergraduate and graduate students, employed research assistants who are not currently in a training program, and post-doctoral fellows. Students who are volunteering at the symposium and/or submitting abstracts will be given priority. Recipients must attend the symposium to receive the stipend, or they must decline/refund the stipend. You can apply to be a volunteer *and* apply for a Student Travel Stipend – **please note that applications are separate.**
